



Fiscal Year 2014 Appropriations Request Form

Congress has renewed its ban on earmarks despite objection from Senator Begich and others who understand this funding's importance for states like Alaska. While Senator Begich will not submit earmark requests to the Senate Appropriations Committee this year, he still wants to hear about Alaska's funding needs. Please feel free to submit your priority projects by no later than February 24, 2013. As a member of the Senate Appropriations Committee, Senator Begich will use this information to advocate for the federal programs most important for Alaska. The projects you submit to the Senator will be publicly available on his website in order to be fully transparent.

You **MUST** have Adobe Reader installed on your computer to fill out this application. The latest version can be obtained here, <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>.

Application Instructions

1. If you need to download or distribute another copy of this form, visit the Appropriations Request section of our website here, <http://begich.senate.gov/public/index.cfm?p=ProjectRequests>.
2. Select 'Download' when prompted and click on the 'Pick location' link to download the file to your desktop. You must have Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat to fill out and submit the form.
3. Locate the file you downloaded and double-click to open it.
4. Fill out all of the required sections completely. There are a set of optional sections that follow the main application. Please make sure to fill out the section that applies to you. The sections outlined in red are required fields.
5. When finished, attach and send the form via email to appropriations@begich.senate.gov.
6. If you would like to save a copy of your submission, click on 'File' and select 'Save As' and specify the appropriate location. **You do not need to send a backup copy of your request via paper mail.**

We prefer you submit your application via this electronic form, but if you must submit this application in paper form, please mail it several weeks in advance of the deadline. Due to delivery delays caused by security precautions, mail can take up to 30 days to reach our office.
